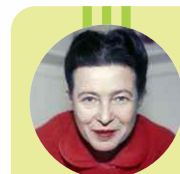

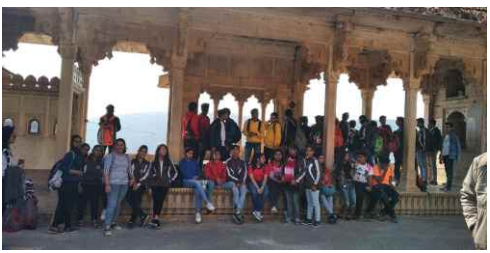
Felicitation for Punctuality
